This year has been challenging to us in many ways. However, the Lord has never left us alone. Ebenezer is the word we shout. For God has helped us make it this far in a year throughout which we have been through a lot. We are thankful for God's sufficient grace. Regarding the Vine Church, the Lord has not ceased to accompany us.

Throughout this year, we have seen 21 people come to the Lord as a result of preaching the Word, Bible study, and personal gospel sharing. This year we have baptized 19 new believers and received 18 new members through affiliation. We praise God for such a harvest in the midst of trials and hardships, as we face them daily in Haiti. Due to the extremely dangerous situation in Haiti, we have painfully seen many people leave the country and our church for the US, Canada, and some other countries like Brazil, Nicaragua, and Chile. Most of those people are professionals from the working class of Haiti. Such a situation has affected our church both numerically and financially. We pray that the Lord would help them keep their faith and the sound teaching of the Bible wherever they may be.



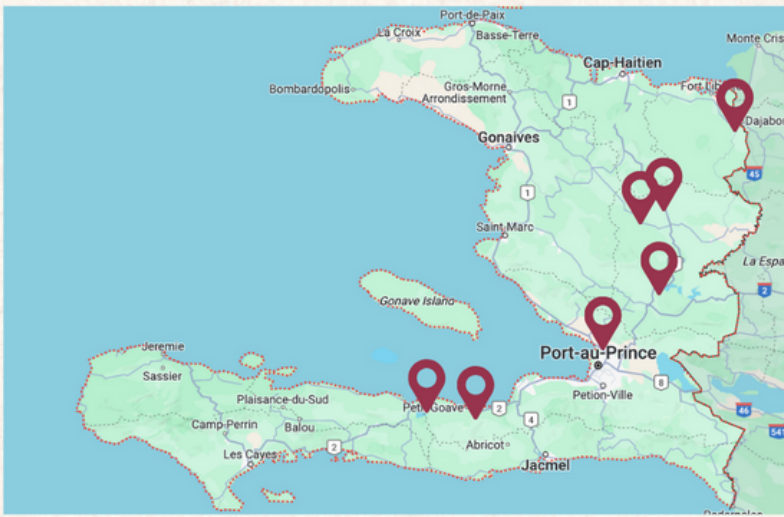
By God's grace, at the Seminary of Evangelical Theology of Port-au-Prince (STEP), we were able to finish the Fall semester. This semester, I have taught three classes of Homiletics and Hebrew. We are thankful that we could have all our classes in person (in the classrooms) in spite of all the turmoil and dangers going around the general area of the seminary. We praise God for his protection.

As for the Bible translation ministry, the Lord has helped us make some good progress this year. I praise God for having helped me make it through Jeremiah and Zechariah, which we were able to recently check. I am now working on the Book of Ezekiel. Then, I will have only Job to work on to finish all the first drafts for all the books of the Old Testament. Praise God! We are progressing toward the finish line.

Your prayers are very important in our ministry. For, as you know, it is tough to face and encounter the devil's scheme trying to keep many people away from the truth and the light of Christ. However, we know the kingdom of darkness will NOT prevail (Isaiah 9: 1-2). So, please, continue to join us in our effort to keep preaching the Gospel, training Pastors and leaders through the teaching of the Word, and translating the Bible by the grace of God. "The LORD bless you and keep you; The LORD make His face shine upon you and be gracious to you; The LORD lift up His countenance upon you and give you peace." (De. 6:24-26).

AFFILIATED CHURCHES

Affiliate church pastors are recipients of the food support program. Three churches (Hatty, Lapila, and Ouanaminthe) received oxen and plow for their communities; a motorcycle was provided for Pastor Evanoir Valbrun and land was purchased for the Church in Hatty through the gifts of Vine Ministry donors.



FOOD SUPPORT PROGRAM

Begun in November of 2023, the temporary food support program is designed to assist those in need during an extraordinarily difficult time. Pastor Daniel administers the program, providing a small stipend of funds so a family can purchase additional food during the month. The program extended support to 32 families last year as well as providing a supplemental meal on Sunday morning at Vine Church. The goal of \$2,000 per month continues in 2024.



STUDENT SUPPORT

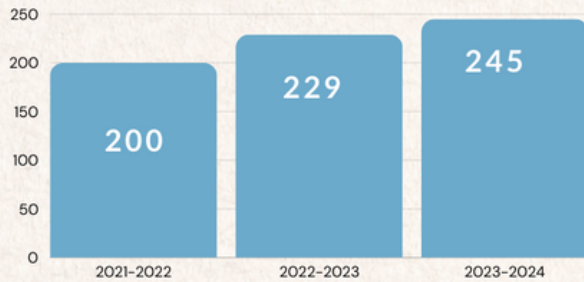

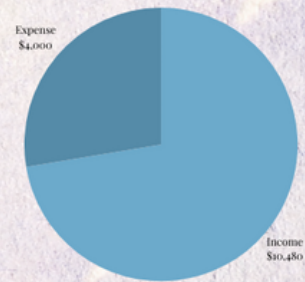

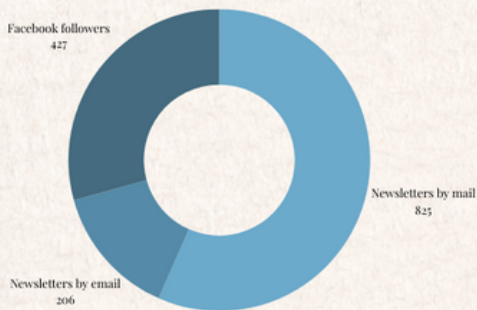

CONNECTIONS WITH DONORS



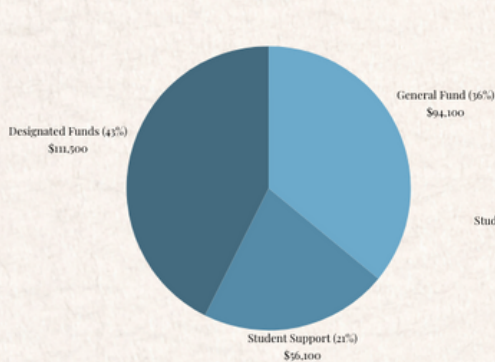

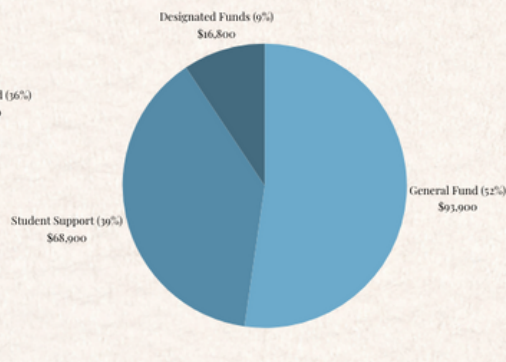

NET INCOME



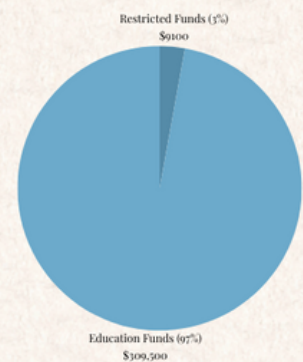
TOTAL = \$261,700
